Favorite Plant Spotlight

I've been growing Dibley's Streptocarpus 'Harlequin Lace' for over a year and find it to be an extremely strong grower and producer of beautiful blooms. This plant has been growing in a shallow three inch pot under lights and started blooming in December 2018. The plant now has about a dozen open blooms with more buds still forming and opening! Blooms remain on the plant for many weeks (dare I say months?) and also make excellent cut flowers.

The second photo is an unusual fourpetaled peloric bloom that opened on this plant and is quite a fun surprise! S. 'Harlequin Lace' is easy to start from leaves and, although female sterile, produces abundant pollen. I successfully crossed it with Streptocarpus 'Ladyslippers™ Red Rose' (Dibley's 'Ruby' per Dale Martens) this past fall, and I am currently raising up a bunch of strong growing seedlings in hopes of obtaining a reddish colored bloom with the patterning, strength, and blooming characteristics of Streptocarpus 'Harlequin Lace'.




