Postcards from Sulawesi, Indonesia

The recent Elvin McDonald Research Endowment Fund (EMREF) grant from The Gesneriad Society made it possible to continue my explorations for gesneriads in Sulawesi, Indonesia.

Zulfadli, my botanical colleague and friend, accompanied me on this extended trip through some challenging terrain and weather conditions from July 24 until August 5, 2021. Our fieldwork took us from Palu to Toli-Toli. The adventure began with a 5.6 magnitude earthquake, but we were all right.

We found many plants from various genera and discovered several species new to science. Working with botanists around Indonesia, I am still in the process of identifying some of these plants. Currently, I have successfully identified *Cyrtandra boliohutensis*, *C. celebica*, *C. geocarpa*, *C. hypogea*, *Dorcoceras phillippense*, and *Rhynchoglossum obliquum*. I am still working on other plants including: four cyrtandra, two rhynchotechum, one stauranthera, two aeschynanthus, two monophyllaea and, one pithema and many other plants, including some begonias that have not yet been identified.





To find this plant, we hiked for three hours on foot. This species grows in humid areas or on rocks around river flows with a fairly dense canopy cover. We found this species at an altitude of 400 meters. This species is quite abundant.





The field sampling process at the Malane Falls, Toli-Toli Regency, Central Sulawesi. The route to the Malane Falls can only be accessed by a 30-minute ride on a motorcycle. The three plastic bags that Zulfadli carries are filled with Gesneriaceae samples that have been collected. He also carries a brown bag containing a bottle of alcohol, in which several flower samples from the Gesneriaceae tribe are preserved.





Zulfadli is seen here taking pictures of *Aeschynanthus amboinensis* that we collected near the waters of the Malane Falls, Toli-Toli Regency, Central Sulawesi. *Aeschynanthus amboinensis* has never been reported in Sulawesi before. This specimen is the very first record of *Aeschynanthus amboinensis* in Indonesia.
