The Philadelphia Flower Show (PFS) returned to its usual location and time at the Pennsylvania Convention Center, running from March 4th to the 12th, 2023. It was great to be back home.

This year's theme was THE GARDEN ELECTRIC.

The Hamilton Horticultural Court is where the competitive plant section was staged. This year it was moved to the center and was the featured attraction. There were many plant entries and thousands of people to admire them. The Liberty Bell chapter of The Gesneriad Society donated the awards for the best blooming and best non-blooming gesneriads. 
